Handling Allegations

Course Overview

Ensure owners, directors, senior staff and Designated Safeguarding Officers in recruitment businesses have the knowledge and skills needed to respond to allegations against candidates and staff members.

- Have considered what an allegation is and how allegations may arise (and how these are different from complaints or negative feedback)

- Have discussed their role and responsibilities in effectively managing allegations and how they should work with partners including placements, LADO, social care and the police
- Have considered how to recognise the impact that personal values may have and how to ensure that their practice is evidenced based
- Have had the opportunity to consider the process from beginning to end
- Demonstrate an awareness of the emotional dimension of safeguarding work and identify ways in which they, staff and candidates can be supported during allegation investigations
- Have identified sources of support and advice, and next steps for them as an organisation
